Student Wins at State Level



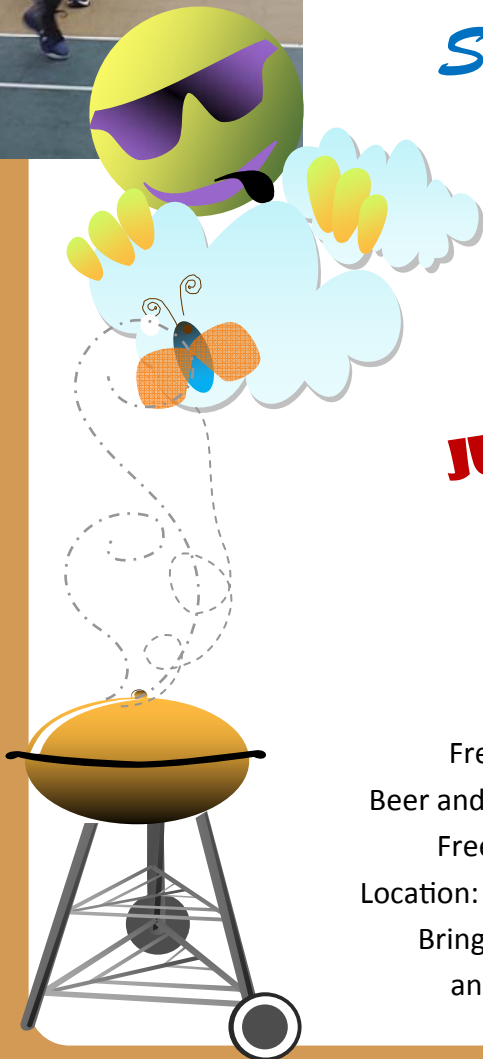
