AUGUST 8 (TUESDAY) - OPEN HOUSE

AUGUST 9 (WEDNESDAY) - FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL- Early Release for All Classes

The school day begins promptly at 8:00 am. All children should be in the classroom by 7:55 am, ready to settle down and begin their day.

MID MORNING BREAK

- SIXTH Grade has a mid-morning snack break @ 9:50am. Please pack a snack/drink or purchase a snack ticket (\$1.50) from the cafeteria **prior to 7:55am.**

★Snack/Drink ticket: \$ 1.50 per day/\$ 7.50 per week

LUNCH

- SIXTH Grade has lunch at 12:35. Lunch tickets should be purchased from the cafeteria **prior to 7:55 am.**

- Pre-purchase tickets weekly or monthly by sending an order form to school with check or cash payment (order form can be found on the School website: www.st-joe-school.org) or by credit card in the cafeteria **prior to 7:55 am.**

There are no IOU'S for lunch, however, if your child is left at school with no lunch, a peanut butter & jelly sandwich, chips & milk will be provided and you will be billed \$ 2.00. However, PB&J is not an option to purchase each day.

★Lunch ticket: \$ 4.00 per day/\$ 20.00 per week

DISMISSAL

- SIXTH Grade dismisses from 3:00-3:10 pm. If you are late picking up, your child will go to aftercare & be charged Extended Day rates, which are explained below. This charge is billed and must be paid weekly.

Extended Day Program - available each day until 6:00 pm.

Charge: \$ 2.50 per half hour or any part thereof
Billed & paid every week

If you pick up after 6:00pm, the charge is \$ 1.00 per minute past 6:00 pm. This fee must be paid to the caregiver personally at the time of pick up.
